COURSE INFORMATION

This qualification reflects the role of educators in early childhood education and care who work in regulated children's education and care services in Australia. Educators at this level are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum that meets the requirements of an approved learning framework and for maintaining compliance in other areas of service operations.



This qualification is typically delivered over a minimum duration of 12-14 months, including 280 hours of work placement in a regulated long day care facility.



Upon completion of this qualification, students are eligible to apply for roles such as:

- Childhood education manager
- Outside school hours coordinator



This qualification is delivered out of our Maddington and Mandurah locations.

DURATION

This qualification is typically delivered over a minimum duration of 12-14 months, including 280 hours of work placement in a regulated long day care facility.

DELIVERY

The training is conducted by a qualified, industry current, trainer and assessor to ensure the learning is relevant and up to date. This training will take place in a classroom environment using face-to-face training methods at one of our study locations. Intakes are scheduled throughout the year.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry to this qualification is open to individuals who hold either CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care. Students must hold a valid Working with Children Check (WWC) or state equivalent, before participating in practical placement.
