INFORMATION

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs.



This qualification is typically delivered over a duration of 6 months, including 120 hours of work placement in an aged care & disability setting.



Upon completion of this qualification, students are eligible to apply for roles such as:

- Personal Carer
- Support Worker
- Respite Worker

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DURATION

This qualification is typically delivered 2 days a week over a duration of 6 months, including 120 hours of work placement in an aged care & disability setting.

DELIVERY

The training is conducted by a qualified, industry current, trainer and assessor to ensure the learning is relevant and up to date. This training will take place in a classroom environment using face-to-face training methods at one of our study locations. Intakes are scheduled throughout the year.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements however students will need to be at least 17 years and 6 months at the time of enrolment to ensure practical placement can be gained along with the required checks. Students must also have current COVID-19 and Influenza vaccinations.
